

Casting an Absentee Ballot

If you are not able to attend this year's Community Celebration on Wednesday, October 3, 2018 we still want to capture your vote for this year's grant recipient.

Prior to voting, please thoroughly review each finalist's Executive Summary, which can be found at www.impact100eastbay.org under Grants, Grant Finalists. The 2018 finalists are CASA of Contra Costa County, Opportunity Junction, and Renaissance Entrepreneurship Center.

Absentee voting may be accomplished in one of two ways:

1. By submitting a completed Ballot & signed Conflict of Interest Form
OR
2. By submitting a completed Proxy form & signed Conflict of Interest form.

How to Receive an Absentee Ballot, Proxy Form & Conflict of Interest Form

There are two methods available to you:

1. Download forms from the Member Portal at www.impact100eastbay.org. Access the Member Portal on the website by logging on with your User ID (email address) and password to download the absentee ballot. If you do not know your password, use the password reset option.
2. Request forms by email from the Membership chair who will be tracking RSVPs at info@impact100eastbay.org.

Returning Forms and Due Dates

Regardless of the method you choose, a correctly completed **Ballot** OR a correctly completed & signed **Designation and Appointment of Proxy** form AND a correctly completed and signed **Conflict of Interest** form must be returned to Impact 100 East Bay:

- By email to info@impact100eastbay.org no later than 6 pm PDT on Tuesday, October 2, 2018.
OR
- By USPS to Impact 100 East Bay, P.O. Box 2889, Castro Valley, CA 94546 postmarked no later than Saturday, September 29.
